PLEASE REMEMBER THERE IS A WATER BOIL ADVISORY IN EFFECT. This information is updated on the city of Augusta website as well.

Key things to remember:

You are still responsible for cleaning out your refrigerator and disposing spoiled food. Failure to do so could result in AHA charging you a cleaning fee of \$50.00 or a total refrigerator replacement fee of \$550.00. Rent is still due and payable in accordance with your lease agreement. If you are experiencing a hardship you will need to reach out directly to your Property Manager. Please keep in mind due to lack of power and or internet some offices may not be opened. You can however email your manager or drop a note in their office Dropbox. Everyone will be contacted accordingly.
